**DEFINITION OF CHILD TRAFFICKING**

Child trafficking is any act involved in the recruitment, transportation or sale of children within and across international borders through fraud, coercion or force. The purpose of the trafficking is to place or maintain a child in a situation of forced labor, such as prostitution, domestic servitude or other forms of slavery.

**FACTS & TRUTH**

- There are more slaves today than there were in 400 years of African slave trade.
- Where poverty is present, there are traffickers ready to exploit it.
- Poverty forces parents to think and do the unthinkable, “Should I sell my child?”
- Human trafficking is tied with illegal arms. It is the fastest growing source of money for organized crime.
- 1 million children worldwide are forced into prostitution each year.
- “Human trafficking generates **\$31 billion** annually and enslaves **27 million** people around the globe, half of them children under the age of eighteen.”
- Put into perspective, that staggering number of **27 million** slaves would equal every single resident in 13 of the largest U.S. cities. Imagine all the people living in New York City, Los Angeles, Chicago, Houston, Philadelphia, Phoenix, San Antonio, San Diego, Dallas, San Jose, Detroit, Indianapolis, and Jacksonville, ALL of them—and that would equal just under **27 million** people.
