- 1 Did anyone in your group memorize Ephesians 5:1-2 last week? If so, ask them to recite it for the group. How can we be "imitators of God" when it comes to alcohol?
- 2 How has your background or upbringing influenced your perspective on alcohol? How does it align with what the Bible has to say about the topic?
- 3 Have someone read Ephesians 5:18. Paul interestingly compares the imagery of being filled with wine with being filled with the spirit. The differences are obvious – talk about any similarities between the two.
- 4 The issue of legalism is often associated with the topic of alcohol. What other ways does legalism creep into our spiritual lives? How can we guard against “majoring in minors?”
- 5 What commitment did you make on this weekend’s Connection Card? How can your group help you fulfill that commitment?
