Parents As Partners

Parents, you are responsible for the spiritual development of your children. However, you need to be equipped and encouraged to minister to your children. Therefore, we believe parents and church leaders must partner together in an effort to offer children the best spiritual training.

You will be given tools that enable you to teach and reinforce Bible lessons being taught at church. Bible stories, memorized Scriptures, and life application projects must be reinforced at home to take effect in a child's life. Church teaching alone is not enough. Both parents and the church must become partners in an effort to encourage children to become like Christ. Your responsibility is to (1) teach your children, (2) be a godly example before your children, and (3) to have fun times with your children.

Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. Impress this teaching and God's commands on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates.
