NORTHSHORE WOMEN'S RETREAT MARCH 12-14, 2010

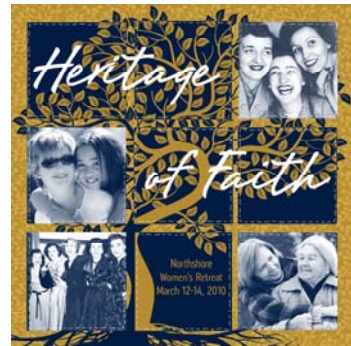
Some Questions you might be asking:

Where do we eat?

Meals are served family style in the Camp Dining Hall. You will be served breakfast, lunch and dinner on Saturday and breakfast on Sunday. There is an espresso stand in Cedar Lodge and pop/snack machines as well. Vegetarian meals are available upon request (See the registration form). Friday and Saturday night we offer really good munchies. Feel free to bring a snack to share.

What time does retreat start and end?

We start signing in at 6:30 PM on Friday, Mar 12. The program begins at 7:30 PM (Saturday Only Women should arrive at 8:30 AM to sign in. Program begins at 9:30 AM). The Retreat ends around noon on Sunday.



What are the Saturday options?

In the afternoon you can ride a horse or venture out on the ropes course (there is an additional cost for these events). There are special prayer times and a variety of workshops. Other options include: take a nap; go on a nature walk; talk with friends, play board games...



Where is retreat and where would I sleep?

What is the cost of retreat?

The cost of retreat for lodging in Cascadian Lodge and Mt. Baker Cabins is \$125. For more hotel-like accommodations: Olympic View Lodge, \$185-Double occupancy, \$165- Triple occupancy.

Saturday only: \$60- This price includes all Saturday events, lunch and dinner but **no** lodging.

Scholarships: Full and partial scholarships are available on a need basis; please pick up a form at the registration counter. College students may apply for a scholarship.
